SC Faculty Meeting

1. The meeting minutes from 1/11/2012 were approved.
2. The budget meeting with the Dean's Office was on February 8. At this meeting, money allocation for the upcoming year was discussed. We are getting the same amount as the current year. We must create courses with the current resources then prove that more resources are needed. The department cannot grow the graduate program if there are no strong roots with the undergraduate program.
3. The undergraduate course ISC3313 Intro to Sci. Computing is proving to be a very popular course. Enrollment is growing every semester because students seem to like the small class size. Extra lab sections or bigger classes need to be created to meet demands for the class.
4. The computational science minor was voted on and approved by all faculties present at the meeting.
5. The 1000 level course was mentioned to a few people outside of science for their opinions.
6. The expo will be held April 11. It will operate the same as last year with Post-Docs and undergrads invited to participate this time.
7. The next TCC day event will be Wednesday, February 14. We will be there with the same setup as last semester. Also, on that same day is the STEAM event for the exploratory students here at FSU. We will also be participating in that event.
